Minutes of Meeting Durbin Crossing Community Development District

The regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of the Durbin Crossing Community Development District was held Monday, February 22, 2021 at 6:00 p.m. at the Durbin South Amenity Center, 145 South Durbin Parkway, Jacksonville, Florida.

The following is a summary of the discussions and actions taken at the February 22, 2021 meeting. An audio copy of the proceedings can be obtained by contacting the District Manager.

FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS

Pledge of Allegiance

Mr. Oliver called the meeting to order and led the pledge of allegiance.

SECOND ORDER OF BUSINESS

Roll Call

Mr. Oliver called the roll.

THIRD ORDER OF BUSINESS Audience Comments

There being none, the next item followed.

FOURTH ORDER OF BUSINESS Approval of Consent Agenda

- A. Approval of Minutes of the January 25, 2021 Meeting
- B. Balance Sheet and Statement of Revenues and Expenses
- C. Assessment Receipt Schedule

On MOTION by Mr. Brownlee seconded by Mr. Harrah with all in favor the consent agenda items were approved to include amendments to the minutes.

FIFTH ORDER OF BUSINESS Ratification of E-Verify Memorandum of Understanding

Mr. Eckert stated the Florida Statutes changed in 2020, the Florida Legislature adopted a new statute that requires all local governments and most businesses to use the E-Verify System. The district is required to use the E-Verify System if it has employees, which this district does not, however, the District is also required to use E-Verify if it enters into contracts with anybody and that, the District does. Therefore, this memorandum of understanding was set forth by the Department of Homeland Security as well as the Social Security Administration and is a form of contract that we don't have any ability to modify, but it is a requirement for us to comply with the state law.

On MOTION by Mr. Pollicino seconded by Mr. Brownlee with all in favor the E-Verify System memorandum of understanding was ratified.

SIXTH ORDER OF BUSINESS Staff Reports

A. Landscape Maintenance Team - Report

Mr. Constancio gave an overview of the maintenance that took place since the last meeting and stated aeration will happen between May and June, granular fertilizer follows pre-emergents that we have been using during the winter, but aerification will make a difference going forward.

B. District Counsel

There being none, the next item followed.

C. District Engineer

Mr. Katsaras stated the traffic signals at Durbin Parkway and Longleaf Pine, there was a utility conflict with one of the foundations. They think they have a resolution for it and are waiting to hear back from the county as to whether they will approve that resolution. Hopefully, it will be by the beginning of March, at which point they can proceed with the foundation installation on the last foundation. Hopefully, that will go in by mid-March then at that point it will be a 45-day time period from when the foundations are in as to when the signals would be up and flashing. By this schedule and things may change, it will be flashing by May 1.

I visited the upland area behind Lot 599 Saddlestone Drive and the sod did extend beyond the resident's lot, but they mentioned that there was some silt fence that might have been cleared as part of the original Durbin Crossing development. I told them to stop maintaining that area, don't mow it, let the natural vegetation take hold again and they agreed to do that. Todd and I can go periodically to see how it is doing.

Mr. Brownlee stated I noticed the foundation for the new traffic light, one of them is in the middle of the sidewalk. I presume the plan includes putting in some new sidewalk.

Mr. Katsaras stated I don't have the plan in front of me but if there is conflict, they are going to adjust the sidewalk or there will be enough clear space for the pedestrian to go around the new signal.

Mr. Brownlee asked did the resident on Saddlestone move their wood pile?

Mr. Katsaras responded I didn't see anything as far as a wood pile. There were a few older trees that had been cut down, but they were not very big in size, small pines. It didn't look like oaks or anything like that. There were three or so, it wasn't a lot. It was more that the underbrush was a concern in my opinion.

Mr. Pollicino asked as far as the traffic light, do we know if we are getting stainless steel poles or something a little softer like the brown poles they have on other parts of Longleaf?

Mr. Katsaras stated I don't know but I will find out and report back to Daniel.

D. District Manager

There being none, the next item followed.

E. General Manager - Report

Mr. Myhill gave an overview of the general manager's report, copy of which was included in the agenda package.

F. Operations Manager - Report

Mr. Harrah stated I asked that Justin and his staff prepare a spreadsheet as they find items in the community that need attention that will come to the board monthly so that we know the item, the proposed fix and estimated cost and priority. Even though I think the VerdoGo enhancements would be nice I think there are other things on the list that need more attention such as the tennis court fences are bowed out and things like that. Before you vote on pressure washing, I recommend looking through this list for items that may be more pressing than pressure washing.

Mr. Harrah left the meeting at this time.

On MOTION by Mr. Pollicino seconded by Mr. Brownlee with four in favor staff was authorized to proceed with the items outlined on the spreadsheet on page 108 with the exception of the existing play feature in the amount of \$68,646.26 and poles for the tennis nets in the amount of \$25,000 each for the north and south amenity facilities, which are deferred until the next meeting.

G. Amenity Manager – Report

Ms. DeMarco gave an overview of the amenity manager report, copy of which was included in the agenda package.

The fee agreement in place between our firm and the District contemplates adjustments to the hourly rates from time to time after an annual evaluation by our firm. Our firm has not increased the hourly rates being charged to the District since 2019. Our firm is respectfully submitting this proposal to increase our standard hourly rates well in advance of the budget creation for the next fiscal year. My hourly rate is proposed to adjust from \$315 to \$335. The hourly rate for associates most likely to provide services to the District is proposed to range from \$265-\$285. I would ask that this letter be added to the next agenda for Board consideration.

COUNTY MOWING ON ST. JOHNS PARKWAY:

The county continues to mow District property on St. Johns Pkwy and I continue monitor their schedule and work. The County has started the widening project of veterans Parkway I have been attending meetings and trying to figure out any issues or changes that will be made to our entrance at Saint Andrews. Nothing to report at this time and I will continue to give updates as I get them.

SAINT JOHN'S COUNTY REQUESTED ITEMS :

I have asked them to do an inspection of all of our road striping, turning Lane markers ,and stop sign markers, and restripe anything that is not in compliance. Still waiting to hear from them regarding their report.

The traffic light installation has begun. The estimated completion is sometime in May if work stays on schedule. Three of the four streetlight peers have been placed because of an issue with the 4th pier they had to make adjustments and we have been delayed. ETM will keep me informed of any necessary traffic control or lane closures so we can alert residents quickly and stay ahead of any issues.

LANDSCAPE ENHANCEMENTS UPDATE:

I have been working with Jaime from Verdego. We have come up with a schedule to complete all approved work from the last board meeting. Work began on Friday March 12 around the South amenity center and we will be following the painters at the North amenity center. The new flower rotation will be going in in the month of March any input from the board as to what they like to see would be greatly appreciated. The broken submeter on Isles broke up by the baseball fields has been fixed and all water is back on.

CAPITAL ENHANCEMENT PROJECTS UPDATE:

Investment Painting has begun the painting of the North amenity center and will then move to the South amenity center before starting on all of the monuments throughout the neighborhood on . The South amenity center has been completed and once all of the painting project is complete will do a final punch list to touch up any areas of concern. The pond bank erosion issue behind 1124 Ashfield Way. At this point we have a fully executed contract with Estate management, and work is scheduled to begin mid-March with the completion date of about 30 days. Spoke with John crab from estate management and they informed me that they will be starting the work on Monday the 15th of March.



SOLITUDE LAKE MAINTENANCE:

With the recent amount of rainfall and warmer weather I have asked Solitude to treat several instances of algae blooms. Solitude continues to perform and communicate at a high level throughout the community. They have been onsite for the contracted six (6) times, as well as fulfilled any callbacks that we requested. We are pleased with the communication as well as the product we are receiving. I have also requested, per contract, that Solitude take the recommendations from their tech, Thomas, to add fish to the ponds where the aquatic grass is outgrowing what the current reduced number of fish can handle. Solitude has stated that they will be adding extra fish to those ponds. That work was to be undertaken in the cooler months. I have followed up with solitude On 03 11/2021 for an update as to when this will be completed and I'm still awaiting a response at this time.

VERDEGO / No Board action required:

Our new Account Manager, Jaime, has been highly engaged with me on Durbin and Palisades.

• VerdeGo's Detail Team devoted three (3) consecutive teams to Durbin during the second week of each month. This process began August 10^{th.} This process has been going very well and we have removed a considerable amount of dead plant material throughout the community.

FIELD OPERATIONS UPDATE / (No Board action required):

- Started an Excel sheet with lists of items that need repair or replace throughout the community. Will present to the chair members monthly with progress reported and things that still need to be done. Adjusted the Excel spreadsheet adjusted the Excel spreadsheet to be in compliance with the chairman's request from the last meeting.
- The old abandoned gate by the water fountains at the North amenity center has been replaced with new fencing so that residents and guest do not mistake it for an entrance.
- Staff continues to routinely monitor our ongoing litter issues throughout the community, including all roads, tree lines, etc.
- We are continually checking the tennis courts for gate and fence functionality as well as intact netting. Please see the Durban crossing spreadsheet for recommendations on fence repairs for the tennis court fencing
- Located and uncovered multiple underground drains to evacuate the rainwater from the north and south pool decks. Still have several drains to locate.
- Continue to repair/replace dog waste dispensers where necessary, due to excessive community use.
- Continue to replace faulty light bulbs throughout.



- Cut out old rusty saddle for the slide on the play feature in the zero entry at the North amenity center and replaced it with a brand new one to improve looks and functionality.
- Community streetlight check was performed on March 10, 20212nd, and a report was made to JEA.
- We continue monitoring crack weeds in sidewalks and patio areas and around pool decks.
- We have had multiple requests to remove or fell dead trees from preserve areas that threaten private property. I have contacted Tree Tech to handle anything beyond my capacity. Maintenance staff has completed the removal of all trees we could manage safely to save the District money.
- Staff is routinely working to keep playground mulch levelled and presentable on a daily basis
- All pools, playgrounds, basketball courts and tennis facilities are working properly. Recently replaced the hinges on the gates of both tennis courts.
- We've had a handful of reports of irrigation breaks via the app and we've responded within 12 hours in most cases.
- Ordered pole padding for the basketball courts at North Durban To bring us in compliance with the insurance inspector for Durban crossing. This work has been completed.

ITEMS COMING IN THE NEAR FUTURE:

- Repair stucco at dumpster bay. This is included in the proposal for painting of monuments and amenity centers.
- Ordered an received new basketball goals for both the North and South amenity center and we will start replacing them as time allows.
